His virgin birth (Matt 1:18, Luke 1:34-35, Isaiah 7:14)

His sinless life (2 Cor. 5:21, Hebrews 4:15, 7:26-27, 1 John 3:5, 1 Peter 2:22)

His Miracles (Matthew 4:23, Luke 6:17-19, John 3:2)

His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood (Col 1:14, 20, Romans 5:8-9, Eph 1:7)

His bodily resurrection (1Cor 15:3-4, Luke 24:4-7, 36-48, Rev 1:17-18)

His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Acts 2:32-33, 5:30-31, 1 Peter 3:22)

In His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Philip 2:9-11, 1 Thess 1:10, 4:13-18, John 14:1-3)

That justification by faith in the atonement of Jesus Christ and regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for the salvation of lost and sinful man (Rom 3:24-25 John 3:3-7, 1 John 5:11-15, Eph 2:1-16, Rev 5:9, Acts 4:12, 1 Cor 6:11)

The prime agency for the work of God's kingdom is the Christian local church functioning under the sovereignty of our Lord Jesus Christ. To the church have been entrusted the ordinances of Believer's baptism and the Lord's supper (Acts 2:41-47, 16:4-5, Matt 16:18, 28:18-20 Eph 1:22-23, 1 Cor 12, 1 Cor 11:23-26)

In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit which includes: the Baptism in the Holy Spirit as an experience distinct from regeneration; His indwelling, by which the Christian is enabled to live a godly life; His supernatural gifting and empowering of the Church for its work, life and Worship. In the return of Jesus Christ, to consummate His Kingdom. In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; those who are saved into the resurrection of life, and those who are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29, Mark 14:62, 2 Thess 1:2-10, Rev 1:5-7 20:4-5 11-12)

In the Spiritual Unity of Believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (John 17:11, 21-23, Rom 12:4-5, Eph 4:11-16)
